Modular Format

SUPERA is easily tailored to specific curriculum and assessment strategies. Its modular approach offers a wide range of content and assessment options to meet your needs, from curriculum goals to reporting requirements to testing program design.

The assessment series includes four components:

SUPERA Evaluaciones esenciales (Survey) is a selected-response test in reading/language and mathematics, when your testing time is limited, is the best choice for Grades K–10.

SUPERA Evaluaciones múltiples (Multiple Assessments) is a combination of selected-response items and open-ended assessment activities that allows students in Grades K–10 to produce short and extended responses right in the test book.

SUPERA Plus (a supplemental edition that may be used with either Multiple Assessments or Survey) assesses word analysis, vocabulary, language mechanics, spelling, and mathematics computation in a separate book. These tests can be used to provide additional information for planning instruction or creating lesson plans that focus on specific learning areas.

(Custom Assessments) are assessments that allow you to select the appropriate mix of content and assessment methods for a clear picture of student achievement. Educators can create a customized *SUPERA* assessment to meet local curriculum needs for students in Grades 1–10.
